



Can base station communication equipment be sold abroad

Defense trade between the United States and its foreign allies and partners is authorized and supported by various central statutes.

Options to remedy this situation are to return the equipment to the originating port, or obtain a proper equipment authorization. In some cases, equipment may be placed in a bonded warehouse, or ...

The importation of radio communications equipment is regulated as required by law and (a) to ensure public safety and security; and (b) to adhere to international standards.
