

Can the back of photovoltaic panels be washed with water How to wash it

Dust that accumulates on solar panels is a major problem, but washing the panels uses huge amounts of water. Engineers have now developed a waterless cleaning method to remove dust ...

If water is not enough to remove dirt, you can use mild soap or specialist products designed for cleaning photovoltaic panels. It is also important not to use high-pressure washers.

Clean the solar panels after they have cooled down. Avoid using cold water during high-temperature periods to prevent thermal shock. Use a hose with a gentle spray nozzle and make sure ...
