El Salvador uses electrical outlets and power plugs of types A & B (see images). If your country uses the same electrical outlets and power plugs, you don't need a travel adapter.

There are two types of domestic wall outlets in use in El Salvador: the ungrounded type A (NEMA 1-15) and the grounded type B (NEMA 5-15). The ungrounded type A plug has two flat ...

Yes, you can use your laptop or smartphone in El Salvador without any issues, as the voltages are similar (120 V and 115 V) and the frequency the same in both countries (60 Hz).

In El Salvador, known for its stunning volcanoes and coffee plantations, they use type A and B outlets. As an American, you won't need to worry about packing a travel adapter.
