

Lithium battery energy storage project in Italy

Where in Italy will a new battery energy storage system be built?

The largest project, a 160 MW facility, will be built in the municipality of Tuscania. Italy's Ministry of the Environment and Energy Security (Mase) has issued final approvals for five new battery energy storage system (BESS) projects, paving the way for 361 MW of new capacity to be added to the nation's grid.
