



## **Togolese oil refinery uses 80kWh collapsible containers**

Fuel imports, despite Nigeria's vast crude oil reserves, have been necessary due to insufficient local refining capacity--a problem the Dangote refinery wishes to solve.

Had the Eastern Refinery Limited (ERL) built its second unit as planned a decade back, Togo could have largely averted the fuel oil shocks and gained from discounted Russian oil as some other countries did.

The Dangote oil refinery is expected to help Nigeria resolve its oil export-import paradox. Indeed, the country relies heavily on refined oil imports though it is an oil-exporting nation.
